



OFFICIAL ROAD CLOSING NOTICE

State to State Half-Marathon & 5K – Sunday, Sept. 26, 2010

The Police and the State to State Planning Committee will work to balance your transportation needs AND the safety of runners, walkers and local race volunteers.

1. **HIGH St. from POPLAR TO BEECH - CLOSED** to traffic from about 5:00 a.m. -2:00 p.m.
2. **HIGH St. from BEECH west TO LOCUST-CLOSED** to traffic from about 7:00am-12:30 p.m.
3. **CONTRERAS from LOCUST west to KNOLLS (includes traffic coming from Stone Creek, Prevalent, Patrick, Fieldcrest, Ridge, Panda, James, Dick, Lynn, Hilltop, Jacqueline, Olde Farm and Country Club)**
 - BOTH LANES CLOSED to traffic from about 7:15 am - 9:15 am
 - ONE LANE ONLY from 9:15 am until 11:30 pm
4. **KNOLLS - Knollwood – KNOLLS RESIDENTS PLEASE USE BACK ENTRANCE ONTO FAIRFIELD** to avoid race traffic.
5. **WEST OF THE KNOLLS (Oxford Township, Indiana)**
 - Contreras will be CLOSED to through traffic WEST of the Knolls (toward Indiana). Motorists will be escorted by Butler or Union Co. deputies as needed when race traffic permits. Emergency vehicles will be able to get through. Road will re-open gradually as runners complete course.

TRAFFIC WILL MOVE EAST TOWARDS TOWN ONLY

Drivers needing access to Contreras during the open periods will be directed EAST, towards Oxford, to keep all traffic on the one lane available moving in the same direction. Please follow traffic monitor and police guidance.

3. **CONTRERAS from LOCUST west to KNOLLS (includes traffic coming from Stone Creek, Prevalent, Patrick, Fieldcrest, Ridge, Panda, James, Dick, Lynn, Hilltop, Jacqueline, Olde Farm and Country Club)**
 - **BOTH LANES CLOSED** to traffic from about 7:15 am - 9:15 am
 - **ONE LANE ONLY** from 9:15 am until 11:30 pm
4. **KNOLLS - Knollwood – KNOLLS RESIDENTS PLEASE USE BACK ENTRANCE ONTO FAIRFIELD** to avoid race traffic.
5. **WEST OF THE KNOLLS (Oxford Township, Indiana)**
 - Contreras will be **CLOSED** to through traffic **WEST** of the Knolls (toward Indiana). Motorists will be escorted by Butler or Union Co. deputies as needed when race traffic permits. Emergency vehicles will be able to get through. Road will re-open gradually as runners complete course.
